Acromec steps up diversification strategy with renewable energy 80%-owned subsidiary Acropower and expansion into Indonesia with 67%-owned subsidiary Acromec Trading Indonesia

- Move into renewable energy sector with the incorporation of Acropower Pte. Ltd., an 80:20 venture with Malaysia's Green Energy Resources (M) Sdn Bhd, pursuant to the MOU signed in February 2018
- Incorporation of PT Acromec Trading Indonesia, allowing ACROMEC to provide its engineering products and solutions to customers in ASEAN's biggest economy, in line with its future plans to expand beyond its current presence in Singapore, first disclosed in its Offer Document dated 6 April 2016

SINGAPORE, 13 MARCH 2018 - ACROMEC Limited ("ACROMEC", or the "Company" and together with its subsidiaries, the "Group") today announced that it has incorporated two companies to carry out its diversification strategy into the renewable energy sector and its expansion into Indonesia, ASEAN's biggest economy.

The setting up of Acropower Pte. Ltd. ("Acropower"), an 80:20 venture with Malaysian green energy specialist, Green Energy Resources (M) Sdn Bhd ("GER"), gives ACROMEC an opportunity to tap on its core expertise and experience to provide sustainable energy solutions to the renewable energy sector.

The incorporation of Acropower represents the Group's next move towards the renewable energy sector, after both parties had signed a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") in early February to explore opportunities in the renewable energy sector. Both ACROMEC and GER, pursuant to the MOU, will commit manpower and other resources to explore opportunities for Acropower to work on projects related to electricity generation using sustainable feedstock, possibly on a build-own-operate basis (the "Projects").

Renewable energy plants require precision control of variables such as temperature and moisture levels. ACROMEC will contribute its expertise in controlled environments engineering while GER will contribute its expertise in green technologies.

In Indonesia, ACROMEC will provide engineering products and solutions through PT Acromec Trading Indonesia ("Acromec Indonesia"), including those with high-specification Biosafety level 3 classification, to customers in ASEAN's biggest economy. Indonesia is the Group's first step into expanding in South East Asia. The Group will continue to explore opportunities into other countries in the region.

Mr Lim Say Chin, Executive Chairman and Managing Director of ACROMEC, said: "Even as we continue to grow ACROMEC organically, the two ventures reaffirm our focus to expand our business by diversifying and expanding our geographic footprint and solutions range, through acquisitions,



joint ventures or strategic alliances, with partners who can create synergy with ACROMEC's existing businesses."

The Projects are subject to, amongst other things, the execution of the definitive agreements in relation to the above and there is no certainty or assurance that the definitive agreements will be entered into or that the Projects will take place. The Company will make the necessary announcements as and when there are material developments to the above matter and other matters contained in this media release.
