Resolution 2

To re-elect Mr Goi Chew Leng who is retiring pursuant to Article 108 of the Company's Constitution (the "Constitution") and who, being eligible, offers himself for re-election as a Director of the Company.

Mr Goi Chew Leng will, upon re-election as a Director of the Company, remain as a member of the Audit Committee and the Board does not consider him to be independent for the purpose of Rule 704(7) of the Listing Manual (Section B: Rules of Catalist) of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (the "SGX-ST") (the "Catalist Rules").

To re-elect Ms Elaine Beh Pur-Lin who is retiring pursuant to Article 108 of the Constitution and who, being eligible, offers herself

for re-election as a Director of the Company.

Ms Elaine Beh Pur-Lin will, upon re-election as a Director of the Company, remain as a member of the Audit Committee and the Board considers her to be independent for the purpose of Rule 704(7) of the Catalist Rules.

Resolution 6 To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an Ordinary Resolution, with or without modifications:

"Authority to allot and issue shares That pursuant to Section 161 of the Companies Act, Chapter 50 of Singapore, and the Listing Manual (Section B: Rules of Catalist) of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (the "SGX-ST") (the "Catalist Rules"), authority be and is hereby given to the directors of the Company (the "Directors") to:

allot and issue shares in the capital of the Company ("Shares") whether by way of rights, bonus or otherwise; and/or (A) (i) (ii)

make or grant offers, agreements or options (collectively, "Instruments") that might or would require Shares to be issued, including but not limited to the creation and issue of (as well as adjustments to) warrants, debentures or other instruments convertible into Shares, at any time and upon such terms and conditions and for such purposes and to such persons as the Directors may in their absolute discretion deem fit; and

(notwithstanding that the authority conferred by this Resolution may have ceased to be in force) issue Shares in pursuance of any Instrument made or granted by the Directors while this authority was in force,

- the aggregate number of Shares to be issued pursuant to this authority (including Shares to be issued in pursuance of Instruments made or granted pursuant to this authority) does not exceed one hundred per cent (100%) of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) (as calculated in accordance with sub-paragraph (2) below) ("Issued Shares"), of which the aggregate number of Shares to be issued other than on a pro-rata basis to the existing shareholders of the Company (including Shares to be issued in pursuance of Instruments made or granted pursuant to this authority) does not exceed fifty per cent (50%) of the total number of Issued Shares; (subject to such manner of calculation as may be prescribed by the SGX-ST) for the purpose of determining the aggregate number of Shares that may be issued under sub-paragraph (1) above, the percentage of Issued Shares shall be based on the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) at the time this authority is given, after adjusting for:

 (i) new Shares arising from the conversion or exercise of any convertible securities:
- - new Shares arising from the conversion or exercise of any convertible securities;
 - new Shares arising from the exercise of share options or vesting of share awards which are outstanding or subsisting at the time this authority is given, provided the options or awards were granted in compliance with Part VIII of Chapter 8 of the Catalist Rules; and
 - any subsequent bonus issue, consolidation or sub-division of Shares;
- in exercising the authority conferred by this Resolution, the Directors shall comply with the provisions of the Catalist Rules for the time being in force (unless such compliance has been waived by the SGX-ST) and the Constitution for the time being of the Company; and
- (unless revoked or varied by the Company in general meeting) the authority conferred by this Resolution shall continue in force until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company or the date by which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by law to be held, whichever is the earlier."

Resolution 7

To consider and, if thought fit, pass the following resolution as an Ordinary Resolution:

"Authority to allot and issue shares pursuant to the Acromec Performance Share Scheme

That pursuant to Section 161 of the Companies Act, Chapter 50 of Singapore, the directors of the Company (the "Directors") be authorised and empowered to grant awards in accordance with the provisions of the Acromec Performance Share Scheme (the "Share Scheme") and to allot and issue from time to time such number of shares in the capital of the Company ("Shares") as may be required to be issued pursuant to the vesting of the awards under the Share Scheme, provided that the aggregate number of new Shares which may be issued pursuant to the vesting of awards under the Share Scheme, when added to the number of new Shares issued and issuable in respect of all awards granted under the Share Scheme and any other share-based incentive scheme of the Company for the time being in force, shall not exceed fifteen per cent (15%) of the total number of issued Shares (excluding of the Company for the time being in force, shall not exceed fifteen per cent (15%) of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) preceding that date of grant of award and such authority shall, unless revoked or varied by the Company in general meeting, continue in force until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting or the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by law to be held, whichever is earlier."

Resolution 8

To consider and, if thought fit, pass the following resolution as an Ordinary Resolution:

That:

- for the purposes of Sections 76C and 76E of the Companies Act, Chapter 50 (the "Companies Act"), the exercise by the Directors of the Company of all the powers of the Company to purchase or otherwise acquire ordinary shares ("Shares") in the issued share capital of the Company not exceeding in aggregate the Prescribed Limit (as hereafter defined), at such price or prices as may be determined by the directors of the Company from time to time up to the Maximum Price (as hereafter defined), whether by way of:
 - market purchases (each a "Market Purchase") on the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited ("SGX-ST") transacted through one or more duly licensed stockbrokers appointed by the Company for the purpose; and/or
 - off-market purchases (each an "Off-Market Purchase") effected otherwise than on the SGX-ST in accordance with any equal access scheme as may be determined or formulated by the directors of the Company as they consider fit, such scheme shall satisfy all the conditions prescribed by the Companies Act,

- and otherwise in accordance with all other laws, regulations and rules of the SGX-ST as may for the time being be applicable, be and is hereby authorised and approved generally and unconditionally (the "Share Purchase Mandate"); the authority conferred on the directors of the Company pursuant to the Share Purchase Mandate may be exercised by the directors of the Company at any time and from time to time during the period commencing from the passing of this Resolution and expiring on the earliest of:
 - the date on which the next annual general meeting of the Company is held or required by law to be held; the date on which Share purchases have been carried out to the full extent of the Share Purchase Mandate; or (ii)
 - (iii) the date on which the authority contained in the Share Purchase Mandate is varied or revoked by an ordinary resolution of shareholders of the Company in general meeting;
- - "Prescribed Limit" means 10% of the issued ordinary Shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings, if any) of the Company as at the date of the passing of this Resolution; and "Maximum Price" in relation to a Share to be purchased, means an amount (excluding brokerage, commissions, stamp duties, applicable goods and services tax and other related expenses) not exceeding: in the case of a Market Purchase: 105% of the Average Closing Price; and
 - in the case of an Off-Market Purchase: 120% of the Average Closing Price, where: "Average Closing Price" is the average of the closing market prices of a Share over the last five Market Days, on which
 - transactions in the Shares were recorded, preceding the day of the Market Purchase by the Company or, as the case may be, the day of the making of the offer pursuant to the Off-Market Purchase, and deemed to be adjusted for any corporate action that occurs after such five-market day period;

"day of the making of the offer" means the day on which the Company announces its intention to make an offer for the purchase of Shares from shareholders of the Company stating the purchase price (which shall not be more than the Maximum Price calculated on the foregoing basis) for each Share and the relevant terms of the equal access scheme for effecting the Off-Market Purchase; and "Market Day" means a day on which the SGX-ST is open for trading in securities; and

the directors of the Company be and are hereby authorised to complete and do all such acts and things (including executing

Under the Catalist Rules, a share issue mandate approved by shareholders as a ordinary resolution will enable directors of an issuer to issue an aggregate number of new shares and convertible securities of the issuer of up to 100% of the issued share (ii)
- capital of the issuer (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) as at the time of passing of the resolution approving the share issue mandate, of which the aggregate number of new shares and convertibles securities issued other than on a pro-rata basis to existing shareholders must be not more than 50% of the issued share capital of the issuer (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings).

Ordinary Resolution 6, if passed, will empower the Directors from the date of the above AGM until the date of the next annual general meeting, to allot and issue Shares and/or Instruments. The aggregate number of Shares (including Shares to be issued in pursuance of Instruments made or granted) which the Directors may allot and issue under this Resolution, shall not exceed 100% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings). For issues of Shares and convertible securities other than on a pro-rata basis to all shareholders, the aggregate number of Shares and convertible securities to be issued shall not exceed 50% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings). This authority will, unless previously revoked or varied at a general meeting, expire at the next annual general meeting of the Company or the date by which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by law to be held, whichever is earlier. However, notwithstanding the cessation of this authority, the Directors are empowered to issue Shares pursuant to any convertible securities issued under this authority. convertible securities issued under this authority.

- Ordinary Resolution 7, if passed, will empower the Directors to grant awards under the Share Scheme and to allot and issue Shares pursuant to the vesting of the awards under the Share Scheme, provided that the aggregate number of new Shares which may be issued under the Share Scheme, when added to the number of Shares issued and issuable in respect of all awards granted under the Share Scheme and any other share-based incentive scheme of the Company for the time being in force, shall not exceed 15% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares and subsidiary holdings) preceding that date of Ordinary Resolution 8, if passed, will renew the mandate to permit the Company to purchase or otherwise acquire its issued ordinary shares on the terms and subject to the conditions of this Resolution.
